Holy Week and Easter Services

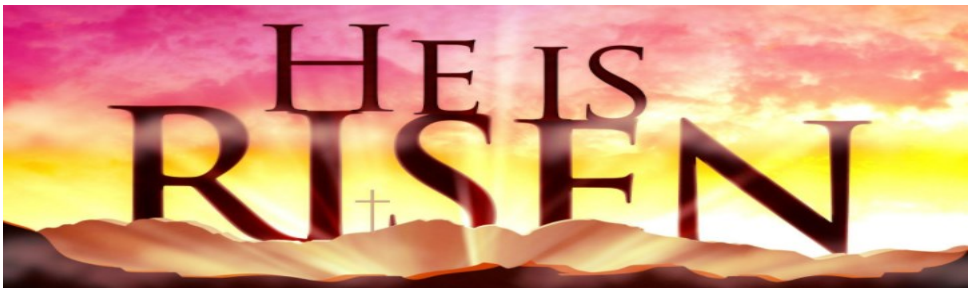
Following the livestreamed service on Palm Sunday (3/28), Holy Week will continue with livestreamed services on

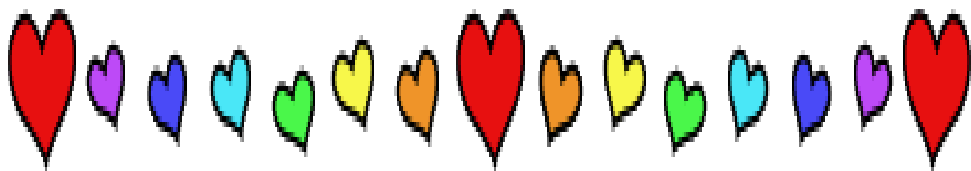
Mission Pill Bottle Collection

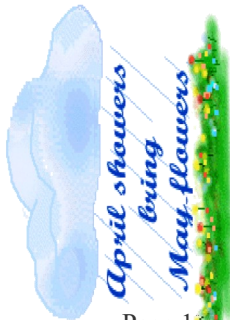
