FINANCE COMMITTEE LOOKING TO "PAY IT FORWARD"

Over the past several years, our Finance Committee has worked diligently to retire as much debt as possible in order to free up financial resources for mission and ministry. The progress we have made thus far has been most helpful. Looking to continue that effort, the Finance Committee - in collaboration with the Church Council - has decided to offer yet another opportunity to the congregation for debt relief: paying off our loan on the Orbit Parsonage.

Paying off this loan would free up \$1,100 a month – a great help to our annual budget. Thanks to some generous gifts prior to the pandemic, we have the resources to do this. However, for the sake of fiscal security, it would be far better to receive additional contributions from you, the congregation, toward this effort, rather than expend the total amount from our accounts. We are, after all, committed to faithful, responsible stewardship of our resources, and to the long term institutional health of LOUMC.

On Sunday, June 6th, Don Tyrrell, our Finance Chair, will be making a brief presentation on our congregation's finances. He will also fill you in further on the specifics of this effort, which will run through the month of June. As always, he, and others from the Finance Committee, are available to answer any questions you might have. We hope and pray that, to the best of your ability, you will commit to being a part of this effort.



Memorial Walk and Garden

In celebration of LOUMC's 140th Anniversary, a memory garden/walk was created. The memory walk includes engraved bricks that honor the memory of departed family and friends. The cost of each 8" x 4" brick is \$50, which includes the lettering (14 spaces/3 lines) and placement in the memory walk. Work on the garden/walk begins in early spring. PROGRAM UPDATE! The Federal government



announced changes to summer food program funding for the next couple of years to address the growing issue of hunger during the summer months which was heightened as a result of the pandemic. The plan will provide up to 34 million children about \$375 each to buy food for the

approximately 10 weeks they are out of school in the summer. That's around \$7 a weekday. As a result, we will not be running Blessings in a Brown Bag FREE Summer Lunch Program this summer. We will evaluate the need next year based upon community feedback.



Community Meals Update - we continue to provide about 120 meals each Monday at LOUMC. Of these meals approximately 60 are delivered to our Community Meals family either by teams of drivers or taken to Heritage Place and delivered. We are grateful to Kathy McMinn and her team of drivers as well as Kathy Castillo delivering to Heritage Place. We have adjusted our pick up times in the Anderson Street parking lot to 5:30 to 6:00 pm (no longer until 6:30). While we are using small teams on Sunday and Monday to cook and pack meals if you would like to work ,on occasion, please contact Nancy Ochoa at ochoanancyj@gmail.com. to get on the volunteer list. We appreciate the support of the congregation in the Community Meals Program and continue to seek both your participation and contributions to this program. We are able to provide this outreach because of your generous donations and find that the program has increased costs now due to the cost of packaging. Any gardeners out there have some spare time? Could you help water our flowers? Help out with weeding or




planting? Contact Debbie Schmidt or Kathy McMinn to get on the list to spend an hour to help them keep our flower and memorial gardens beautiful!
