



The 41st annual Lake Orion / Oxford CROP walk was a traditional 2 mile or 10k walk beginning at Christ the Redeemer on May 7th or walk on-your-own. The walk was a huge success! We raised \$1,580 more than last year. (\$12,620 total in 2022).




