
WORLD COMMUNION SUNDAY

On October 3rd, we – with Christian faith communities from around the globe - will celebrate World Communion Sunday. World Communion Sunday began in 1936 in the Presbyterian Church and was adopted by the Federal Council of Churches in 1940. Since then, the celebration has grown into an international ecumenical celebration of – as well as an enacted prayer for – Christian unity.

It is a day when we mark the almost universal Christian practice of breaking bread with one another, giving thanks for all God has done and continues to do for us, remembering Jesus (particularly his institution of the New Covenant at the Last Supper), and obtaining a foretaste of God's "still coming" kingdom where we will all feast together at the heavenly banquet.

World Communion Sunday reminds us that – in every language and through various customs and forms of liturgy – the fellowship of Holy Communion is celebrated throughout Christ's universal Church. At its best, therefore, World Communion

Sunday serves two purposes: it is both a joyous and meaningful partaking in Jesus' sacred meal with his friends and a mind-opening, hearttransforming exposure to our sisters and brothers from around the world and their different traditions. In recognition of these different traditions, we are privileged that our Worship and Arts crew will decorate the altar with breads from around the world.





Finance Committee Spotlight



Meet David Fairchild, our other Treasurer of the team

Dave tells us: Bob and Shirley Dingman preceded us as Treasurers and we had a gradual transition. So when Linda started writing the checks by hand she also posted to a (paper) journal. That journal contained the check number, amount, and the Church accounts that Shirley then used to create the Treasurer's report. Back in those days, Bob used a Lotus spread sheet for the reports. That report format consisted of a Front page that contained budget account numbers and a Back page that contained the reserved Fund balances (that format still applies today). I started by using the Lotus software that Bob created, but soon had to switch to EXCEL. Then in around 1998, I learned about and bought Quicken software. This opened the opportunity for Linda to print the checks with Quicken and record the account numbers for each check. And, Quicken reports replaced the journal. I use Quicken and an EXCEL spread sheet to prepare a Treasurer's report every month.

I attend all the Finance meetings and report on key activity in a draft version. I then send out an approved version of the report.

David is a golfer, a boatman, an angler, and a pilot. For 30 years, Linda and David had a boat in Algonac. From Salmon and Walleye to Perch and Blue Gill, none were safe from "the catch"!

David and Linda have had multiple full-size airplanes and even attended the Experimental Aircraft Association International Fly-In at Oshkosh, Wisconsin. He has a commercial pilot license with an instrument rating. Today, David is an avid builder and flyer of radio-controlled model airplanes.

The current pet of their household is Genny. An earlier pet, Skipper is pictured with Linda on Mackinaw Island. He would ride anywhere with Linda in a basket on the front of that bike. They rode completely around the island and up to arch rock that day – quite a feat for such a small Yorkie! We are blessed to have both Linda and David Fairchild!



Lake Orion UMC was granted through the Small Business Administration \$69,700 from the Paycheck Protection Program. This money was considered a loan and after review of our documentation \$62,218 was converted to a grant with us having to replay the remaining loan portion of \$7,482. Thank you to PMC for their assistance. Also a big thank you to Paul Reile for his work in applying for this funding and to David Fairchild for providing the required documentation.


