WHEN A TREE FALLS IN THE WOODS... GOD HEARS IT



Last month, we hosted a book party and conversation with Paul Nixon and his book *Weird Church*. One of Paul's observations was that, as the Church, we can't be afraid to let go of programs, or old ways of doing things,

once they have run their course. The metaphor he used was that of older growth trees dying in the woods, making way for new growth and regenerating the forest. When we allow the "former things to pass away," we make room for "new creation" – new things – to come to life.

It is tempting to cling to the comfort of what has been rather than taking the risk of letting it go. But this is what Jesus calls us to do for the sake of future growth. And so, while the 3-in-1 program (formerly LOGOS) has served us well in the past, the time has come for us to let it go and to reassess where, in our continued commitment to Family Ministry, we will reallocate our time, effort, and resources.

Be assured that we will be directly communicating this decision with those families that have been participating in the program, and we will continue to look for ways to connect with and support them. We are thankful to all those who, over the years, have been a part of 3-in-1. And we will be counting on you and many others in the future, as we move forward with ministry to children, youth, and families.

Community Meal Hosts


We are in need of more people willing to greet our community meal guests when they come on Monday evenings. It would involve coming at 4:30
