are actively involved in feeding the hungry through their World Thank Offering. Anyone can participate in this project by simply saving your coins throughout the coming year. We suggest you use a special container for your offering. Family members can be encouraged to drop

some coins in the container as a "thank offering" whenever they feel blessed by God. Or you can empty your pocket change in the container on a regular basis. A year's worth of pennies can make a big difference in someone's life. On the Sunday before Thanksgiving, our church collects this money. It is then combined with Thank Offerings all around the world and distributed through the mission programs of United Methodist Women to those who need our help.

If you have participated in this program over the past year, please bring your offering to church on November 20th and place your containers in the baskets by the sanctuary entrances. There will also be Thank Offering labels for your own jars to help you collect your offering for the coming year. If you can't be here on November 20th, please bring your Thank Offering to the church office. We hope everyone in our church will join us in our efforts to feed the hungry.

#### **Prayers and Squares Quilt Ministry**

What is a Prayer Quilt? Can you touch a prayer? Can you pull it close and feel its comfort? You can if it's part of a prayer quilt made by members of Prayers and Squares, The Prayer Quilt Ministry. The idea behind prayer quilts is simple. A heavy thread is used to take stitches through the quilt layers, and the ends are left free to be tied with a square knot. As each knot is tied, a silent prayer is said for someone in special need who then receives the finished quilt. This is not just a gift of a quilt, it is a gift of love and prayer. It is a statement of faith in God and in His power to comfort, strengthen and heal.

The Prayers and Squares committee does not decide someone needs a quilt. We only make quilts when someone has specifically asked us to pray for them. The common factor in recipients is that their situation is a long term issue affecting their lives in many ways—almost always requiring isolation. This includes not only people recovering from major accidents, but also those with degenerative disease and major disease such as cancer which disrupts a normal life for many weeks or months. Also, aging can cause the crisis, whether it is a loss of vision, mobility or independence. It is essential that the recipient know in advance they are being considered, because we are offering our prayers, not "a blanket".

There are flyers at each door with a referral form and this should be given to anyone that meets the criteria and is in need of prayer. The completed form may be given to a pastor, the church secretary, or the Stephen Ministry Coordinator. The Prayer Quilt Ministry also has a mailbox available near the church office. The most important thing to remember is —IT'S ABOUT THE PRAYERS!!!


