#### 4:30 Family Friendly Service

This service, while family-friendly, will not be as "kid-ish" as in previous years. (This

service has often been like Vacation Bible School Christmas!) It will still be shorter and have activity for children, but maintain all the traditional elements of Christmas Eve - carols, communion, and candlelight.

#### 9:00 Choral Service

This service will include all the traditional elements of Christmas Eve – carols, communion, and candlelight – and feature music from the Chancel Choir. This service will most closely resemble our usual

Sunday morning service, including a blend of some contemporary music and videos.

#### 11:00 Midnight Bell Service

This service is traditional as well, with carols, communion, and candlelight. It will offer special gifts of music (rather than the Chancel Choir) and conclude with ringing the church bell and singing a verse of "*It Came Upon the Midnight Clear*" to usher in Christmas morning.

We will be printing historical info about our church for our 150th Anniversary celebration all through 2022. Here's some info for you:

Through the efforts of Donalda Taylor Lessiter, the United Methodist Church of Lake Orion was officially designated a Michigan Historical Site in March 1973.

In 1987 the chancel area in the sanctuary was expanded and the beautiful wood floor was refinished. The current office areas were added at that time.

In 1996 the Sunday School classroom in the Old Testament Wing was renovated. Brighter classrooms and a larger hallway were completed. Rocks from the foundation were visible when the old floors were ripped up.

As Donalda Lessiter expressed it in closing her account of our history at the Centennial Celebration in 1972 - "This is truly a House of God - blessed with a past, a present, and



a future."
