Bear one another's, burdens



We are excited here at LOUMC to be offering extra creativity to our worship format this summer! We are designing the first portion of our Sunday service with our middle and high school youth in mind, and then inviting them to participate in worship before heading back to Youth Café. There, they will continue in interaction with their small groups and their small-group leaders. (Public service announcement: We can always use more small-group

leaders! No theology degree required! Just a heart for youth.)

Already, Pastors Larry and John, our Family Ministry Director, Dawn Ames, and our Music Director, Janice Hammond, are hard at work planning these creative services! The beginning of the service will include a brief teaching on the theme of the day, a video component to support the teaching, and music that is more contemporary in nature and that, often times, will be led by some of our youth. After the youth have gone to Youth Café, the sermon will go into further detail in terms of the theme and the scripture. As well as incorporating our youth into worship, while still honoring their time apart in Youth Café, this format will allow families to continue in conversation together around the morning's subject, since they will have experienced the same material.
