
### Euchre Anyone???

## 2018 Trustees Report to the Congregation

2018 has been a busy and productive year for your Trustees. Below is a list of some of the bigger completed tasks. Smaller jobs like changing furnace filters, inspections for fire extinguishers, boiler, elevator and so on are not included since they are just part of the regular maintenance of any building.

- The two restrooms in the Old Testament wing were completely gutted and remodeled. This was made possible due to an anonymous donor. By supplementing the \$16,000 donation with Home Depot cards that were also donated, we were able to come in under budget by about \$2,000. The donor generously agreed to donate the remaining money to the kitchen remodel fund.
- The toilet in the restroom in Jeri's nursery was worn out so it was replaced at the churches expense. It was then decided to renovate that room that was done using donated Home Depot cards. The restroom in the Sunny Day room was done about a year ago. With the completion of the restroom in Gerry's nursery it means that all the restrooms in the church have been updated.
- A monitor was added so the choir could better see what was being projected. Money was donated to pay for the monitor. The box around the monitor was paid for using donated Home Depot cards.
- The new sign in front of the church was built and funded as John Keller's Eagle Scout project. He took care of the sign design, manufacture, installation and painting. Some trim was added later using donated Home Depot cards.
- The pews have all been reupholstered using funds from Worship and The Arts rummage sale. The fabric was chosen by Worship and the Arts. The trustees just did the scheduling and over saw the installation.
- Last year all the carpet was cleaned including all the offices, classrooms and hallways. That effort was funded through a donation. Some of the carpets had never been cleaned. This year's Trustee budget included funds to clean some of the carpet. That money was used to clean the carpet in room 125 and all the hallways. The plan is to rotate what carpet gets cleaned each year so that all the carpet will be cleaned at least every two to three years.
- 104 S. Slater St. is one of the homes the church owns. This year we had it painted. It has needed painting for years. The job was paid for from rent paid by the tenant.

Thank you to the congregation for your generous support without which none of this would have been possible.


