Seasonal Flu Immunizations for individuals age 7 or older at noon on Sunday, October 6th. We have walk-in slots available beginning at noon and ending approximately 2:00 p.m. We will be offering the following immunizations: Flu (quad; preservative free) \$30.00; Flu High Dose (ages 65 and over) \$30.00.

Cash patients, please have exact change or a check. We are able to directly bill most insurance plans. Flu shots have typically no copay. **We can directly bill for the following insurance plans: Aetna, Blue Cross of Michigan, Blue Care Network, Blue Cross of MI Medicate Advantage, Cigna, United Healthcare, Medicare Part B, and Tricare.**

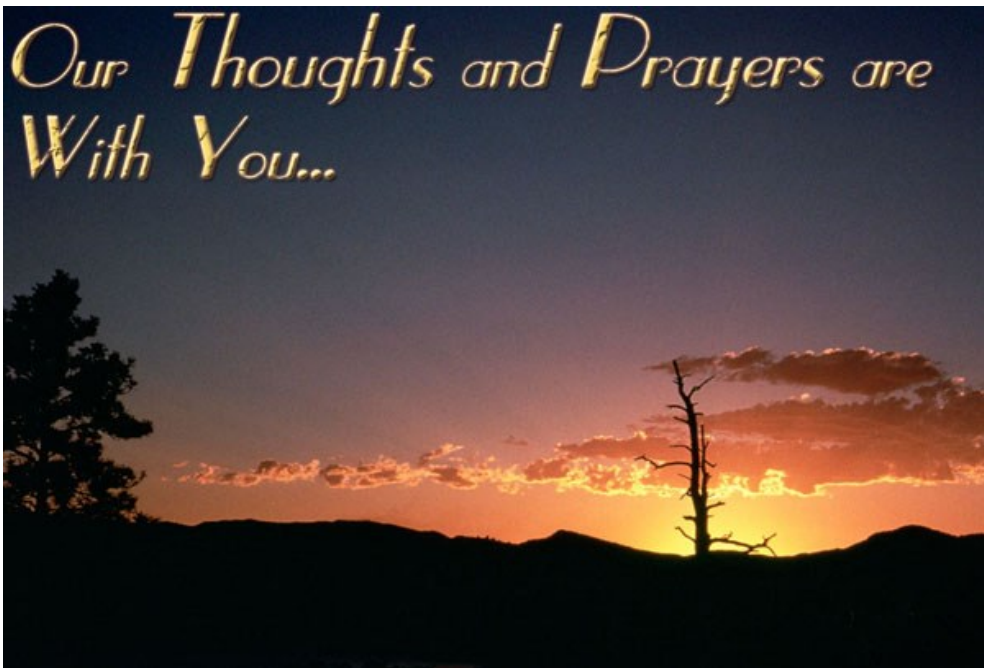
