there are yellow ornaments that indicate a vacuum for each cottage.


They ask that the vacuums be sturdy and easy to clean.

2020 will begin the seventeenth year of this program. Please, plug into this easy fundraising opportunity. Contact Sharon Keener or Trudy Carney for information.




