From February 23-26, delegates from around the world will receive and vote upon different plans offered up by our UM bishops regarding our denomination's diverse views on human sexuality and how our polity might, or might not, reflect that diversity moving forward. 

Middle and High School youth will be participating in the 30 Hour Famine on




